APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 26513, Certificate 9338 and Permit 83592 shall not exceed 11.20 acre-feet annually, or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0155 cubic feet per second, sufficient to water 500 head of cattle, but not to exceed 11.2 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

July 22 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





Applicant proposes to use an existing well to water up to 500 head of cattle. Applicant currently has an existing stock water permit (Permit 26513 Certificate 9338) permitted for 500 head of cattle, applicant proposes to have the combined use of the existing permit and the new application to be limited to 500 head of cattle, not to exceed 11.20 acre feet annually from all sources.

13. Miscellaneous remarks:

The piping from the well is intact, however it was decided not to excavate the well at this time. There was a windmill installed, but has been removed. The applicant holds the grazing rights from the BLM for this grazing allotment.
