1. The source of water is Humboldt River
Name of stream, lake, underground, spring or other sources.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0544 cfs 13.26 acre feet
Second feet, acre-feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Dewatering
Irrigation, power, mining, commercial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals. Must limit to one major use.

4. The water heretofore used for Irrigation
If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point (Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a found section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.)

Portions of the NE1/4 NW1/4, SE1/4 NW1/4, SW1/4 NW1/4, NW1/4 NE1/4, SW1/4 NE1/4, NW1/4 SW1/4, NE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 21, T.34 N., R.55 E., M.D.B. & M., being Parcel No. 1 as shown on the Parcel Map for City of Elko, on file in the Office of the Elko County Recorder, File No. 611051.

Portions of the SE1/4 NE1/4 and the SE1/4 of Section 10, portions of the SW1/4 of Section 11, all in T.34 N., R.55 E., M.D.B. & M. (As Decreed) 4.42 acres of harvest acreage with a priority date of 1890 to be removed from irrigation within the SE1/4 SE1/4 of Section 10, T.34 N., R.55 E., M.D.B. & M.

The point of diversion and place of use of this application is located at the City of Elko Sewer Treatment plant. The City was granted waivers to drill shallow dewatering wells at the plant to accommodate recent construction activities. These wells were utilized to dewater shallow surface waters during construction. They now desire to utilize these wells on an annual basis for maintenance purposes at the facility. This application is being filed to change a portion of Humboldt River Decree Proof 00202 which is controlled by the City for dewatering purposes as a beneficial use per NRS 534.025. The wells will be utilized on an annual basis for 60 days out of the year at a duty of 13.26 acre feet seasonally to allow the City to perform maintenance activities at the plant.
