APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under claim of vested right V06822, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said claim of vested right V06822 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 57805, Certificate 14480; Permit 59294, Certificate 15611; Permit 59295, Certificate 15612; Permit 62334, Certificate 15613; Permit 62335, Certificate 15614; Permit 62336, Certificate 15615; Permit 62337, Certificate 15616; Permits 68928 and 83619 shall not exceed 161.55 acre-feet annually.

This permit is issued subject to any final determination under the claim of vested right V06822 as established in an adjudication of the source.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.2156 cubic feet per second or 49.0 acre-feet annually.


Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before: Filed Under 77611 on August 31, 2010

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: October 13 2016




16. Miscellaneous remarks:
