APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 67240, Certificate 16310 and Permit 83639 shall not exceed 11.20 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The issuance of Permit 83639 expires Temporary Permit 83667T.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0155 cubic feet per second or 11.20 acre-feet annually or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

August 22 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





Applicant proposes to drill a 6" cased stockwell with a submersible pump to provide water to a stock trough. The applicant currently has an existing stockwater permit (Permit 67240 Certificate 16310) permitted for 500 head of cattle, applicant proposes to have the combined use of the existing permit and the new application to be limited to 500 head of cattle, not to exceed 11.20 acre feet annually from all sources. The place of use of this application is on private land.

13. Miscellaneous remarks:

A Report of Conveyance is being filed along with this application, changing the ownership of Permit 67240 to Seven Dot Cattle Co., LLC.
