### PERMIT TO CHANGE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED

**Name of Permittee:** GRANITE PEAK PROPERTIES, L.C.  
**Source:** UNDERGROUND (WELL NO. 5B)  
**Basin:** SNAKE VALLEY  
**Manner of Use:** IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC  
**Period of Use:** ONE YEAR FROM DATE OF ISSUANCE.  
**Priority Date:** 07/05/1995

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#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 63669, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 63669 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 63664, 63665, 63666, 63668, 63669, 63670, 63671, 63672, 63673, 63674, 63675, 63676, 63677, 63678, 63679, 63680, 63681, 63682, 63683, 63684, 63685, 63686, 63687, 63690, 63691, 83675T, 83676T, 83677T, 83678T, V09745, V09746, V09747, and V09748 shall not exceed 3983.8 acre-feet for the irrigation of 1305.76 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

Pursuant to NRS 534.110(2), the permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from each well in this irrigation system and report to the State Engineer upon the expiration of this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.23 cubic feet per second or 42.0 acre-feet annually.**




