APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 23212, Certificate 6523; is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 23212, Certificate 6523; and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 8918, Certificate 2039; Permit 17917, Certificate 5564; Permit 17918, Certificate 5565; Permit 23212, Certificate 6523; Permit 51325, Certificate 12561; Proof of Appropriation V10507; and Permit 83694T shall not exceed 15.68 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0093 cubic feet per second or 6.72 acre-feet annually, sufficient to water 300 head of cattle.**




