APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 64265, Certificate 15941; is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 64265, Certificate 15941 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 63064, Certificate 15932; Permit 63065, Certificate 15933; Permit 63072, Certificate 15934; Permit 63074, Certificate 15935; Permit 63456, Certificate 15939; Permit 63708, Certificate 15940; Permit 64265, Certificate 15941; Permit 64266, Certificate 15942; Permit 64268, Certificate 15943; Permit 64269, Certificate 15944; Permit 71953, Certificate 17302; Permit 71954, Certificate 17303; Permit 71955, Certificate 17304; Permit 71956, Certificate 17305; Permit 71957, Certificate 17306; Temporary Permit 83726T and Temporary Permit 83727T shall not exceed 151.0 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 37.75 acres within the described place of use. Rotation in use of this water is allowed under NRS 533.075 anywhere within the described place of this temporary permit.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.04445 cubic feet per second or 8.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed an annual duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:


