This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of La Madre Spring as heretofore granted under Permit 9274, Certificate 2285, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 9274, Certificate 2285 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued for wildlife purposes within the described place of use, further identified by the Clark County Assessor as portions of APN's 136-29-000-001 and 136-32-000-001.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.15 cubic feet per second or 108.0 acre-feet annually.**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:






16. Miscellaneous remarks:
