This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Permit 68666, which changed the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of Claims 177, 178, 204, and Permit 11489, Certificate 4827, which changed the point of diversion of Claim 262, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued subject to continuing jurisdiction by the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on December 31, 2014, at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.





Permit 74495 is a permanent appropriation to divert Truckee River water into the Verdi Lake (Pond) located in the Crystal Peak Park in Verdi to account for the annual evaporation losses. However, in order to protect the fish habitat in the lake, additional flow-through/flushing flows are necessary. This temporary application represents a non-consumptive use of water associated with the flow-through/flushing flows at the Verdi Lake (Pond). This additional water is diverted from the Truckee River and flows back into the Truckee River.
