APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 63673, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 63673 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 26735, Certificate 9480; Permits 63664, 63665, 63666, 63667, 63668, 63669, 63670, 63671, 63672, 63673, 63674, 63675, 63676, 63677, 63678, 63679, 63680, 63681, 63682, 63683, 63684, 63685, 63686, 63687, 63688, 63689, 63690, 63691, 83675T, 83676T, 83677T, 83678T, 83923T, 83924T, 83925T, 83926T, 83927T, 83928T, 83929T, 83930T, 83931T, 83932T, 83933T, 83934T, 83935T, 83936T, 83937T, 83938T, 83939T, 83940T, 83941T, 83942T, 83943T, 83944T, 83945T, 83946T, 83947T, V09745, V09746, V09747, and V09748 shall not exceed 3,983.8 acre-feet for the irrigation of 1,305.76 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Pursuant to NRS 534.110(2), the permittee shall be required to keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from each well in this irrigation system and reported to the State Engineer upon the expiration of this temporary permit.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire April 17, 2015, at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second or 90.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:




