APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 24145, Certificate 6634, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 24145, Certificate 6634 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 24145, Certificate 6634 and Temporary Permit 83981T shall not exceed 1,083.28 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 270.82 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 4.0 cubic feet per second or 810.0 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**



The existing production well has declined in production rate but still provides usable water flows for irrigation purposes. A new well is proposed to provide additional pumping capacity to continue irrigation of the entire place of use. A waiver to explore for a production well site has been filed and once the new production well has been drilled, a survey will be completed to provide a tie, bearing and distance. A permanent application will be filed when the production well has been completed and in production.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Central Nevada Hay Company has purchased Section 30 T26N, R43E, MDM and appurtenant water rights under Permit Nos. 24145 and 18936 from Stan and Janice Driskell as documented under Document No. 214053 dated November 18, 1999, Book 470 Page 530 in Lander Co. A Report of Conveyance and supporting documents will be filed in the near future.
