APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 68398, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 68398 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit is issued for irrigation purposes within the described place of use, further identified as Lyon County Assessor's Parcel Number 004-152-04. This permit cannot be sold separately or otherwise transferred or conveyed from this place of use. Any attempts to change the place of use of this permit will be denied.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0047 cubic feet per second or 1.1287 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 16 2018

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





Attachment to Support Application to Change

Item No. 15. Provide a detailed description of the proposed project and its water usage:

This application to change is being filed in conjunction with the class action settlement of Roeder et al. v. Atlantic Richfield Co., et al., Case No. 3:11-CV-00105-RCJ-WGC, U.S. District Court, District of Nevada (Roeder Case) judgment dated October 21, 2013. The water right herein described will be limited to exterior demands only of a domestic well as described in NRS 534.013 for the well on the property described in this application. The water right will transfer with the property and cannot be separately sold or otherwise transferred or conveyed. The water under this proposed application to change may be used to continue to irrigate applicant's existing lawn, garden or provide water for domestic animals and pets kept for noncommercial use. The household water services will be disconnected from the domestic well and supplied by connection to municipal water purveyor facilities.

Once the connection is constructed and municipal service is available the applicant acknowledges the requirement to prepare and file the required proof of completion of work and proof of beneficial use to maintain the permit in good standing.
