APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 82145, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 82145 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.021 cubic feet per second, sufficient to water 3,300 head of sheep, but not to exceed 14.78 acre-feet annually.**





Water will be utilized on a daily basis as needed to provide water to the sheep herds within the place of use. Water troughs are moved every day to provide water to the herds, the herds can move as far as 5 miles in one day and may not make it back to the same place for months. This application will be able to help maintain water for the herd during this dry year. The herds can consist of up to 3300 head of sheep within this area.
