APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 23253, Certificate 7866, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 23253, Certificate 7866 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 23253, Certificate 7866; Permit 28363, Certificate 10986; Permit 43728, Certificate 13959; Permit 48073, Certificate 13075; and Permit 84053T shall not exceed 171.19 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

Permit 23253, Certificate 7866 and Permit 28363, Certificate 10986 are supplemental for 99.254 acre-feet annually. Upon approval of this temporary application, the amount of water available for appropriation under Permit 28363, Certificate 10986 is limited to 13 acre-feet annually.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.
