APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 80234, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 80234 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total land irrigated under Permits 84056 and any water of the Walker River Decree shall not exceed 25 acres within the described place of use. This permit for underground water is issued as a supplemental water supply to lands that have surface water rights from the Walker River as set forth in Claim Number 168 and 170 of the Walker River Decree C-125. Underground water shall not be pumped from the well described in this permit except to the extent necessary to make up the portion of the entitled duty from Decree water in any given year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, not to exceed 0.072 cubic feet per second or 28.276 acre-feet seasonally, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

November 17 2016

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




