APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56961, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56961 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 54243, 56961, 64061, and 84175T shall not exceed 1,448.52 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire one year after the issue date at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.



This application will be used primarily to supply additional water to Bald Mountain Mine's Mooney Basin operations. The water will be diverted from an existing production well in Ruby Valley and used primarily for an expanded heap leach facility within the Ruby Valley and Long Valley hydrographic basins. This application is intended to supersede and replace Permit 82953T, which expires on August 12, 2014. The applicant has filed a permanent change application and is working to complete an inventory of Ruby Valley as required by NRS 533.364 so that the permanent application may be acted on. The applicant needs this temporary application to obtain the necessary water while the permanent application is pending.
