**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 18954, Certificate 6246, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 18954, Certificate 6246, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis by February 15th of each year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 84176, 84177, 84178, 84179, and 84180 shall not exceed 2,450.4 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 612.6 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is supplemental to surface water rights under Permit 23310, Certificate 7385 and Decreed Claim V02409 (Willow Creek Decree), and as such, cannot be pumped unless there is no surface water available.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.5648 cubic feet per second or 521.33 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

January 29, 2016

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

January 29, 2019



## THE STATE OF NEVADA

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The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis by February 15th of each year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 84176, 84177, 84178, 84179, and 84180 shall not exceed 3,657.68 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 914.42 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is supplemental to surface water rights under Permit 23310, Certificate 7385 and Decreed Claim V02409 (Willow Creek Decree), and as such, cannot be pumped unless there is no surface water available.

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
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
