This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee and Carson Rivers as set forth under the Newlands Reclamation Project rights in the Truckee and Carson River Final Decrees, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decrees and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 533.040 Paragraph 4 and is limited to the irrigation of 1.5 acres within the proposed place of use.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 6.75 acre-feet as decreed.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before: **Filed Under 62742 on June 25, 1998**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: **December 22 2017**


