APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 78953 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 78953 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water having the same place of use under Permit 9521, Certificate 2281; Permit 23312, Certificate 6968; Permit 28347, Certificate 9255; Permit 45469, Certificate 13464; Permit 78952, Permit 78953 and Permit 84231T shall not exceed 2,895.81 acre-feet.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.306 cubic feet per second or 221.7 acre-feet annually.**



Response to Application item 15 and 16:

(15) Description of Proposed Project

The Town of Battle Mountain proposes to drill one (1) new municipal supply well to serve the community. This well will provide redundancy to the system which currently requires 100% availability in order to meet peak demand.

The proposed project includes installation of a new 16inch diameter well, well testing, pump purchase, electrical gear purchase, construction of new power line to the site, construction of a well house and ~12,000 feet of transmission pipeline to existing tanks.

Application #83901 for new appropriation for this new well was received by the NDWR office on June 13, 2014 and should be ready for action/protest near the end of August 2014.

(16) Miscellaneous Remarks

The closest existing wells (Permit 78952 & 78953) to the proposed site located ~4,200 feet to the southeast belong to the Town of Battle Mountain and provide drinking water to the community. Newmont Mining Corporation owns the next closes well (Permit 22883) located ~4,000 feet south. Newmont's Water Rights Administrator has been contacted regarding details of this municipal project and expressed no concerns to any part of the project including the Transfer of Point of diversion.

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
