
Twin declines are to be constructed as part of new mining exploration. Water developed will be used in the drilling process, dust control, and exploration. Water use will be made in conjunction with Application to Change Permit 19093, Certificate 6656 being filed concurrently. The total combined duty under this Application and Application to Change Permit 19093, Certificate 6656 shall not exceed 124 million gallons annually (380.54 AFA). It is anticipated that the existing Point of Diversion will be utilized by Barrick - Cortez for stock purposes in the future.
