APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30319, Certificate 10725, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30319, Certificate 10725, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.045 cubic feet per second or 24.4 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.





New center pivot and irrigation lines to be installed on Ranch to replace wheel line irrigation. Irrigation of pivot to occur through use of existing well, pump, and motor. Permanent change applications to be filed in the future. New proposed center pivot to be irrigated with a combination of portions of existing certificated groundwater rights and this temporary change application. Center pivot will be fully irrigated by groundwater. Please refer to attached map.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Water to be Stripped from sole source certificated place of use at 3.452 acre-feet per acre (per certificate terms of Permit 30319/ Cert. 10725) and placed in the proposed place of use at 4.0 acre-feet per acre duty.
