### PERMIT TO CHANGE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED

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#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 77702, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 77702, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records must be submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis within 30 days after the end of each calendar year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is issued under the preferred use provisions of NRS Chapter 534. The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.3 cubic feet per second or 30.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





Water from the point of diversion will be used for the construction and maintenance of proposed mine roads, haul roads, and dust abatement for the roads and mining areas. An estimated seven (7) loads per day of 4,000 gallon trucks for 365 days a year will be consumed. A minor volume of water will be utilized for temporary occupancy of mobile office facility. The expanded proposed place of use includes additional access roads, haul roads and mining areas under the South Relief Canyon mining project.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Nevada Cement Company will continue to work with the BLM to obtain the necessary permitting to drill the well approved under Permit No. 77702. Provisions required from the BLM to obtain approval of Permit No. 77702 are understood to apply to this change application.
