APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 50865, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 50865 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis by February 15th of each year.

The issuance of this permit expires temporary permit 83912T.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 14347, Certificate 7270; Permit 20361, Certificate 5922; Permit 41120, Certificate 13575; Permits 41122, 50172, 52015, 52333, 53027 and 56981, Permit 61594, Certificate 15801; Permit 61595, Certificate 15802; Permit 61975, Permit 63879, Certificate 17154; Permits 67729, 67730, 69273, 73298, 76179, 77945, 77946, 77947, 77948, 84411, 84412, 84440, 84441, 84442, 84443 and 84444 shall not exceed 11,207 acre feet annually.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second or 448.06 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

May 28 2016

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

May 28 2020




