

Existing well and pump will be equipped with a pipeline distribution system and water troughs to water approximately 600 head of cattle daily for approximately 130 days per year. The period of use will depend on weather and grazing conditions within the proposed place of use. Cattle may be present during spring and fall with the possibility of some cattle present on site year round.
