BLM proposes to construct and install a spring box and/or other collection system at the spring source, and to install a pipeline (approximately 100 feet) to transport water to one trough. Trough would be placed allowing animals year-round access and to protect water and riparian resources.

Calculation of water need applied at 14 gpd for deer and elk. Total available water cannot be assessed until maintenance and installation of the trough is installed.
