APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. This permit is issued subject to any determination of the waters of Willow Spring that may be made under adjudication proceedings under NRS 533.090 through 533.320.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.015 cubic feet per second, sufficient to water 400 head of cattle, but not to exceed 6.75 acre-feet per season.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

July 22 2016

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




