APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 82105, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 82105 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030.

The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis by February 15th of each year.

The well must be sealed from ground level to 100 feet in accordance with NAC 534.380.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 84546 and 84547 shall not exceed 500 acre-feet annually.

The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the groundwater basin.

This permit will expire on December 31, 2023, and all rights herein will revert to the source.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.6684 cubic feet per second or 300.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

June 19 2017

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




