APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the proof of completion of work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit is issued for commercial purposes within the described place of use, further identified by Carson City Assessor as APN 008-611-39.

Upon cessation of pumping for commercial purposes at this place of use, water under this permit shall return to the source and no application to change or relinquishment will be allowed. Additionally, this permit is issued subject to NRS 534.120(3)(a) and as such, may be revoked when municipal water becomes available.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second or 1.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

March 11 2016

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

Tim McCarville LLC was formed on Sept. 30, 2003 with Tim McCarville as the President of the corporation. The corporation is further described as Entity Number: LLC14814-2003; Nevada Business I.D.: NV20031149946. The expiration date of the business license is listed as 9/30/2015, Expiration Date of the corporation is 9/30/2503. Tim McCarville is listed as the Managing Member and Manager.

- 1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.02 cfs, not to exceed 1 acre-foot (0.32585 million gallons) annually
3. The water is to be used for Commercial

The is existing well is described under Drillers Report #13839 that was completed on 2/3/1974. The well is further described as having an 8" diameter casing from 0 to 160' and 6" diameter from 156' to 207' (bottom).

10. Estimated time required to construct works: Well is complete as described by Well Log # 13839.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use: Currently in Use.

The facility is comprised of a garage and storage facility for storing and servicing the tires and wheels that are sold by Carson Tire & Wheel. The sanitary facilities consist of two restrooms, each equipped with a toilet and sink. There is also an outside hydrant that is used in conjunction with the shop facility.


13. Miscellaneous remarks:
