APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 67238, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 67238 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The issuance of this temporary permit reduces the total combined duty under Permit 67238, et al by 100 acre-feet (to 3,580 acre-feet) and reduces the irrigated acreage by 25 acres (to 895 acres).

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

A total of 100.0 acre-feet annually is abrogated from the base right. However, pursuant to NRS 533.3703 only 85.0 acre-feet (the net consumptive use amount) at 0.9 cubic feet per second can be diverted annually.



Applicants have entered into a Lease Agreement with Barrick Gold Exploration Inc. for the water under this Application.
(Lease attached). This Temporary Application is being filed to enable Barrick to perform an extended pump test which will
help determine the quality and quantity of water in the immediate aquifer. The parameters of the pump test require pumping
at rates up to 400 gpm. Barrick has obtained a Temporary Discharge Permit (TNEV2014126) from NDEP.
Base Permit 67238 was permitted for irrigation at a duty of 4.0 af/ ac. so this Application will yield a consumptive duty of
85.0 AFA for the pump test when the NIWR of 3.4 af/ ac. for Basin 129 is taken into account.
