APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 83167, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 83167 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 83167, 84598, 84599 and 84600, having the same commercial use, shall not exceed 211.39 acre-feet annually.

If any water under this permit is cancelled or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

This permit is issued for commercial purposes within the described place of use, further identified by the Clark County Assessor as APN 162-16-613-001.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0849 cubic feet per second or 61.39 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



Attachment**Application to Change the Point of Diversion of a portion under Permit 83167****Item 15 Proposed Project Description:**

The Proposed Point of Diversion is commonly referred to by the Owner as Well #8. Permits 77085 and 83167 for Commercial use are both located in Well #8. The intent of this application is to change a portion of the Point of Diversion under Permit 83167 from Well #8 to Well #2.

The Well #8 discharge was originally connected to the golf course for recreational use. After approval of Permit 77085, the Well #8 discharge has been cross-connected by separate metered line to Wynn Las Vegas Well #2, allowing for commingled commercial use with Permits 60164-65 and 69512 within the Wynn Las Vegas resort complex, primarily for HVAC cooling tower systems. This additional change application will support the proposed comingling of all water rights in Wells #2 & #8 for the same commercial resort hotel use.

The total duty of commingled rights allowed from Well #2 and Well #8, including this change application and existing Permits 60164-65, 69512, 77085 and 83167 will remain 262.93 acre-feet annually, and will be pumped only for resort-related commercial use.

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
