APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 77103, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 77103 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.





This water is being added to an existing well drilled under Application 83090 for dewatering purposes. This water is being applied for irrigation purposes from Shaft Dewatering Well #1. Water from the shaft will be delivered via a pipeline to a field of approximately 100 acres located within the NW1/4 of Section 4, T.12N., R.26E., M.B.D.&M. When the water is not being diverted onto the irrigated field the water will be placed in an infiltration basin located close by at a point from which the NE1/4 corner of section 4, T.12N., R26E., M.D.B. & M BEARS N.86 52'31"E a distance of 4,015.65 feet.
