APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 54293, Certificate 14270, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 54293, Certificate 14270 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Revocable Permit 71339, Permits 84791 and 84792, having a commingled place of use, shall not exceed 18.12 acre-feet annually.

If any water under this permit is cancelled or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

This permit is issued for commercial purposes within the described place of use, further identified by the Clark County Assessor as APN's 191-19-101-003 and 191-19-101-004.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second or 9.3 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





15. Provide a detailed description of the proposed project and its water usage (use attachments if necessary): (Failure to provide a detailed description may cause a delay in processing.)

First, the site will be graded and a limestone outcrop will be processed into aggregate. During this phase water will be required for construction, compaction, dust control, and processing of aggregate. Then two freight terminal buildings with attached offices will be constructed, and much of the remainder of the land will be paved. Water is expected to be used for offices, minor landscaping, and washing of trucks. Finally, the site will be leased.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:
