This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of Pratt Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 61298, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 61298, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.21 cubic feet per second or 63.0 acre-feet per season, but not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

November 16 **2016**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





Permit 61297 and Permit 61298

The point of diversion of Permit 61297 and Permit 61298 is located on National Forest lands. The U.S. National Forest had denied access and construction of improvements at the point of diversion until such time as an easement was issued which has now been completed.

Upon issuance of the easement, the applicant has now improved the existing diversion structure and installed \pm 3.25 miles of pipeline from the diversion to the place of use to improve the efficiency of the existing irrigation system. The cost of these improvements is estimated at \$250,000. These improvements were completed in the fall of 2012 and utilized for the 2013 and 2014 irrigation season. The applicant estimates that they are irrigating the total 70.40 acres allowed for under Permit 61297 and the total 55.26 acres allowed for under Permit 61298.

The point of diversion of Permit 61297 and Permit 61298 as stated on the permits is "As Decreed under Proof No. 00562, Geo. W. Pratt, Edwards Decree within the NE1/4 NE1/4 Section 6, T.41 N., R.54 E., M.D.B. & M.", and is shown as such on the culture map for Proof No. 00562.

During the course of performing surveys for the ranch, it has been determined that the actual point of diversion for these permits is located within the NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 5, T.41 N., R.54 E., M.D.B. & M., possibly due to the dependent resurvey of Sections 5 and 6 performed by the BLM which set the brass cap corner for the Northeast corner of Section 6 also being the Northwest corner of Section 5.

In addition, after further investigation and review of the irrigation system utilized by the applicant, a portion of the waters under Permits 61297 and Permit 61298 are not diverted into the pipeline from the head gate located at the actual point of diversion in the NW1/4 NW1/4 of said Section 5. These waters are allowed to continue downstream in the natural channel of Pratt Creek where it is then diverted from a long standing existing point of diversion located in the NW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 4, T.41 N., R.54 E., M.D.B. & M. From this point of diversion the waters are transferred to the permitted place of use utilizing the historic irrigation ditches as shown on the culture map for Proof No. 00562 where the waters are placed to beneficial use.

Due to the fact that we have now determined that the waters under Permit 61297 and Permit 61298 are not being diverted from the points of diversion as described on the permits, and the fact that the applicant is desirous of accurately reflecting the actual points of diversion of these waters as required, we are filing this application to change the points of diversion to accurately reflect the points of diversion being utilized under these permits.

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
