APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 78451, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 78451 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water granted under Permit 29433, Certificate 15159, (Shafter Well #1); Permit 39110, Certificate 15160, (Shafter Well #2); Permit 49060, Certificate 17190, (Shafter Well #3); Permit 49422, Certificate 17191, (Shafter Well #4); Permit 49595, Certificate 17192, (Shafter Well #5); and Permits 49423, 78451, 84958T, and 84959T shall not exceed 4,335.0 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

A quarterly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter. This report shall be done in accordance with the method specified in the monitoring plan approved by the State Engineer on April 1, 1996.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second or 28.9 acre-feet annually.**






