APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 44007, Certificate 11328, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 44007, Certificate 11328 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 44007, Certificate 11328; Permit 44009, Certificate 11330; Permit 59672, Certificate 14589; Permit 59673, Certificate 14590; and Permit 84960 shall not exceed 26.88 acre-feet annually, sufficient to water 800 head of cattle and 2,000 head of sheep.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, not to exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second and 6.72 acre-feet annually, or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 2 2016

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


