#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 27378, Certificate 8357, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 27378, Certificate 8357, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The place of use of this temporary permit, being 130.47 acres, is supplemental to waters of Bastian Creek under Permits 81072, 81908 and 81909.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.72 cubic feet per second or 521.89 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**







SNWA is filing a single temporary change application to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of supplemental irrigation groundwater rights in Spring Valley under Permit 27378 / Certificate 8357. The proposed place of use is the SNWA Bastian Ranch in Spring Valley as shown in the map accompanying Application No. 39597. Currently this ranch has three surface water irrigation rights: Permits 81072, 81908, and 81909. Permits 81908 and 81909 are for the irrigation of 90.7 acres [supplementally adjusted] from Bastian Creek. Permit 81072 is not to exceed 0.96 cfs or 695.0 AFA for the sole source irrigation of 173.75 acres using the waters of Bastian Creek. The place of use of this temporary change application will be the same as Application 81072.

The result of the approved temporary change application will be the irrigation of 130.47 acres of land at 4.0 acre feet per acre from a single groundwater source. For the 2015 irrigation season, 90.7 acres will be considered supplemental to surface water rights from the Permits 81908 and 81909 and the remaining 39.77 acres will be considered supplemental to surface water rights under Permit 81072.
