APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place of use of the waters of Mullinax Creek, as heretofore appropriated under Proof DLH-0701 as appears in the Little Humboldt River and its Tributaries Decree, No.3157 entered May 9, 1935, in the District Court of the Sixth Judicial District of the State of Nevada, in and for the County of Humboldt, is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

A control device shall be installed at the point of diversion that can be locked or otherwise controlled by the water commissioner.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 2.116 cubic feet per second or 712.91 acre-feet seasonally as decreed.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

June 24 2017

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




