#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 83592, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 83592 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 26513, Certificate 9338 and Permit 85092 shall not exceed 11.20 acre-feet annually, or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **not to exceed 0.0155 cubic feet per second and 11.2 acre-feet annually, or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

January 4 2017

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




