APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 61755, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 61755 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 85099T and 85100T, shall not exceed 135 million gallons annually (414.30 acre-feet annually).

The total combined duty of water under Permit 54498, Permit 56143, Certificate 14698; Permit 56144, Certificate 14699; Permit 56147, Certificate 14700; Permits 61754, 61755, 85099T and 85100T, shall not exceed 485 million gallons annually (1,488.41 acre-feet annually).

This temporary permit is issued as a preferred temporary use for mining & milling purposes within the described place of use, further described by the Clark County Assessor as APN's 185-15-000-003, 185-15-000-004, 185-15-000-005, 185-15-000-006 and 185-22-000-002.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.




