APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 14670, Certificate 5371, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 14670, Certificate 5371 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 85112T, 85113T and 85114T shall not exceed 502.4 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 125.6 acres within the described place of use.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on May 5, 2016, at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit is also issued with the provision that the existing place of use from which water is being transferred shall not be placed to beneficial use under any other water right permits during the duration of this permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.295 cubic feet per second or 150.92 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**







Temp. change application to 14670 will irrigate 37.73 acres, temp. change application to 15224 will irrigate 75.027 acres, and temp. change application to 28039 will irrigate 12.843 acres, for a total of 125.6 acres in proposed place of use in the NW1/4 of Section 8, T. 42 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M.
