### PERMIT TO CHANGE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED

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#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 16816, Certificate 7681, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 16816, Certificate 7681 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under portions of Permit 16590, Certificate 7399; Permit 17102, Certificate 7540; Permit 17104, Certificate 7541; Permit 19369, Certificate 7671; Permit 21321, Certificate 8280; Permit 21323, Certificate 8281; Permit 21324, Certificate 5966; Permit 21327, Certificate 8016; and Permits 65394, 80533, 80534, 80535, 80536, 80537, 80538, 80539, 80897, and 85130 shall not exceed 6,404.63 acre-feet for the irrigation of 1,695.28 acres within the described place of use of this permit (being 2,160 acres). In addition, the total combined duty of all of the above permits and certificated rights shall not exceed 7,132.63 acre-feet, for the irrigation of 1,877.28 acres within 2,342 acres.

Any well drilled under Permit 16816, Certificate 7681 shall be plugged in accordance with the Nevada Administrative Code, Chapter 534.420, "Regulations for Water Well and Related Drilling" within 60 days from the issuance of this permit.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 1.12 cubic feet per second or 279.2 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

June 21 2017

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




