

This is a relocation of an existing irrigation well under Proof V04659. It is also a re-drill of a quasi-municipal well under Permit 72485.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

The existing point of diversion for Proof V04659, a well drilled in 1928 and re-drilled in 1945, has lost production capacity and is located in an inconvenient location for farming purposes. This application will allow the applicant to drill a replacement well. A permanent irrigation application will be submitted upon verification of a successful irrigation well.
