This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion of Claim No. 430 of the Carson River as heretofore granted under the Final Carson River Decree No. D-183, in the District Court of the United States in and for the District of Nevada, is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said Final Decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit is subject to the continuing jurisdiction of the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.




