### PERMIT TO CHANGE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED

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#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore appropriated under Proof of Appropriation V07656 as appears in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights in and to Waters of the Las Vegas Valley Artesian Basin (212), as ordered January 14, 2002, in and for the Eighth District Court of Clark County, Nevada, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter shall be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. A totalizing meter shall be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is submitted. If the well is flowing, a valve shall be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 78888, 78889, 85187 and 85188 shall not exceed 127.02 acre-feet annually.

The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the groundwater basin.

If any water under this permit is cancelled or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.





Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: **December 16 2018**


