APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 59359, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 59359, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from the well and the amount of water used.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.





Due to prolonged drought and early start to irrigation season, additional water and water rights are necessary to augment the Effluent resources for Arrowcreek and Wolf Run golf courses in South Truckee Meadows. This well water will be commingled with effluent resources and delivered to these Golf Courses via existing effluent delivery system.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:
Washoe County will make improvements to the Haufaker effluent reservoir in 2015. These improvements will increase the efficiency of the system, and eliminate the need to augment with other sources of water in coming years.
