APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 44786, Certificate 11902; Permit 50059, Certificate 12676; Permit 57118, Certificate 14363; Permit 58060, Certificate 14597; Permit 58061, Certificate 14598; Permit 58062, Certificate 14599; Permit 58063, Certificate 14600; Permit 58064, Certificate 14601; Permit 58065, Certificate 14602; Permit 65683, Certificate 16201; Permit 65685, Certificate 16202; Permit 80345; Permit 80826, Certificate 18985; Permit 82079, Certificate 19481; Permit 82080, Certificate 19482; Permits 83304, 83305, 83306, 84560, and 85265; and Proofs of Appropriation V09845, V09846, V09847, V09848, and V09849 shall not exceed 44.81 acre-feet annually, sufficient to water 2,000 head of cattle.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **not to exceed 0.015 cubic feet per second and 10.9 acre-feet annually, or sufficient to water 485 head of cattle.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

December 4 2016

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





This is an existing irrigation well drilled under Permit 23792. The current 16-inch casing will be retro-fitted with six-inch casing. A submersible pump will be installed and then powered by solar panels.

10. Estimated time required to construct works: Well is complete

The Applicant plans to use a well previously drilled under Permit 23792 for Stock Water purposes. The current 16-inch casing will be retro-fitted with 6-inch casing. A submersible pump will be installed and will be powered by solar panels. This well will serve as a back-up well for stock water purposes at the DeLong Ranch.

13. Miscellaneous remarks:

This Application is being submitted as a "new" Application. DeLong Ranches, Inc. has numerous Stock Water Permits in Desert Valley and any "new" water under this Application will be supplemental to the others, so no "new" water is being applied for. The original well drilled under Permit 23792 (Log 9530) was recently plugged and abandoned. A redrill under Permit 23792 (Log 121323) was recently completed.
