APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.01 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed 0.4 acre-feet annually, herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to a beneficial use. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California Nevada Interstate Compact. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The issuance of this permit is to serve one single family dwelling within the described place of use. Any future attempts to change the place of use of this permit will be denied. If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the source.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second or 0.4 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





A 1.25" pipe (inside dimension), that extends about 55' from the low water line of Lake Tahoe. A 1/2 HP submersible pump is used to pump the water to the residence.

9. Estimated cost of works: \$5000.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works: 1 year

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use: 2 years

This system has been in continuous operation since the home was constructed in 1958. It appears that the pump has been upgraded since that time. The original use was domestic water and some landscape, the proposed use will continue to be the same.

13. Miscellaneous remarks:

Under the Truckee River Operating Agreement (TROA) Section 6.D.3 "Unmeasured Residential Uses", the parties to TROA agreed that "water used [in the Lake Tahoe basin] for residential purposes shall be conclusively presumed to divert four-tenths of an acre foot (AF) per residential unit per year as provide in Section 204(b)(2)(B) of the {Truckee River} Settlement Act".
