We are filing this application to change the point of diversion of Permit 74420 in order to drill a new well at the proposed point of diversion with the anticipation of obtaining adequate quantities of water from the new well to fully irrigate the 400 acres permitted. The well located at the existing point of diversion of Permit 74420 will be utilized for stockwater purposes under Permit 81223.
