APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56595, Certificate 14203, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56595, Certificate 14203 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 56594, Certificate 14202; Permit 56597, Certificate 14205; Permit 56598, Certificate 14206; Permit 56599, Certificate 14207; and Permits 85419, and 85420 shall not exceed 616.0 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 154 acres.

If any water under this permit is cancelled or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The total land irrigated under Permit 56594, Certificate 14202; Permit 56597, Certificate 14205; Permit 56598, Certificate 14206; Permit 56599, Certificate 14207; and Permits 85419, and 85420 and any water of the Walker River Decree and any storage water appurtenant to the place of use shall not exceed 154 acres within the described place of use. These permits for underground water are issued as a supplemental water supply to lands that have surface water rights from the Walker River as set forth in Claim Numbers 15, and 106 of the Walker River Decree C-125, or from storage water provided from the Walker River Irrigation District. The total diversion of water for irrigation from any and all sources shall not exceed the duty of water for this place of use as set forth in the Decree. Underground water shall not be pumped from the wells described in these permits except to the extent necessary to make up the portion of the entitled duty from Decree and storage water in any given year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.315 cubic feet per second or 70.842 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:






No proposed project water is to be used to irrigate existing alfalfa, grain crops, and garlic.
