
Water under this application will be used for washing aggregate and dust control at an existing quarry mining operation on the proposed place of use. The water will be pumped from the well to an existing water storage pond on the property for use to produce washed aggregated and for dust control. A change application of the corresponding supplemental portion of water under Permit 61754 (85099T) was filed in conjunction with the original application. This application proposes the new point of diversion to augment additional capacity from the new well.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Issuance of supplemental temporary applications to do drilling for additional capacity for the first temporary application (85100T). All applications use a portion of the same 414.3 Acre Feet. Once sufficient capacity is developed, will proceed to permanent permit accordingly.
